
Construction Training Program Requirements	
Estimated Construction Cost	Apprentice/ On-the-Job Training (OJT) /Construction
	Ready (CR) Trainee Requirements
\$500K to \$2.5M	2 – Construction Ready Trainees*
Over \$2.5M to \$5M	4 - Construction Ready Trainees*
Over \$5M to \$10M	6 - Construction Ready Trainees*
Over \$10M (Significant Budget)	OJT/Apprentice/Graduate/Trainee Minimum 15%

^{*}Requirements may also be satisfied by workers enrolled in or a graduate of a DOL-Registered/Approved Training Program

Regardless of estimated construction cost, no more than 50% of trainees can be graduates of a DOL-Registered/Approved Training Program




Projects Below \$10M







(Question 2 of 4)

- Not Very Knowledgeable






(Question 4 of 4)

How would you asses your organization's level of readiness to meet the needs of General Contractors relating to the CTP?




How much experience do you have working with the City of Austin's Construction Training Program (CTP)?




Significant Experienced


