



## COMMERCIAL FACILITY IRRIGATION ASSESSMENT AW AUTHORIZED IRRIGATION INSPECTOR APPLICATION

The [Commercial Facility Irrigation Assessment Program](#) requires commercial, multi-family, and City of Austin properties one-acre in size or larger to complete an irrigation system inspection every two years.

An **Austin Water (AW) Authorized Irrigation Inspector** must perform these assessments. Irrigation inspectors can apply to become authorized to do inspections for this program.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Must hold a valid [Irrigation Inspector license](#) from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ)
- Must complete an AW Authorized Irrigation Inspector training
- Must submit an AW Authorized Irrigation Inspector application no more than six months after completing the training
  - o Must meet all requirements in City of Austin [Rule R161-13.14](#)
  - o Must agree to follow [Austin City Code Chapter 6-4](#) requirements when performing inspections for this program
  - o AW Authorized Irrigation Inspector status is valid for three years
    - Inspectors must retake the training and submit another application to renew their status
    - Inspectors may withdraw from the program at any time by notifying Austin Water
  - o Austin Water may deny approval of an AW Authorized Irrigation Inspector application or revoke an approved AW Authorized Irrigation Inspector's status for any of the following:
    - Providing incorrect or incomplete information on the application
    - Failing to maintain the Irrigation Inspector license granted by TCEQ
    - Violating [Texas Administrative Code Title 30 Chapter 344](#) requirements

### CHECKLIST

- Complete the AW Authorized Irrigation Inspector training
  - Austin Water holds the training at Waller Creek Center 625 E. 10th St.
  - Register by [email](#). Include your name, address, phone number, email, TCEQ Irrigation Inspector's license number, and company name (*if applicable*)
- Submit the AW Authorized Irrigation Inspector application no more than six months after completing the training
  - Include a copy of your current Irrigation Inspector license from TCEQ
